

As a partner of GFP Global Forwarding Partners, my company fully subscribes to the below business ethics and standards regarding dealings with other GFP membership partners. We understand that failure to comply with these business ethics and standards may lead to termination of membership.



1. To ensure our support to our fellow members through trade, contribution, payment and recommendation
2. To use standard operating and security procedures between each other, and whenever possible to use a mutually agreed upon contract, and/or by means of an agreement with written confirmation.
3. We will extend 30days credit or credit terms shown in our mutually agreed agency agreement and pay by T/T on 30days or within a mutually agreed period with initial credit limit of USD 4000 per month. Our payments will reach our partners by the 15th of the following month and no later. We understand that to protect each other we will inform the GFP Board of ANYONE who has defaulted beyond 45 days to ensure we are protected.
4. To be active in sales endeavours to promote mutual growth
5. To respect other partners existing client bases and confidential business data and to refrain from back-selling
6. In countries where two or more partners are represented, refrain from seeking competitive bids from different members of the GFP within the same market
7. To provide bona fide sales leads when possible
8. To be correctly staffed and trained to the standards expected within the Freight Forwarding Industry
9. To exchange our Standard Trading Conditions and our Financial Background at all times
10. To operate in accordance with all stated shipping advice in writing and/or comply with any written agreements/contracts that exist between my company and another partner
11. To respond to all communications (within 24hours) and quote rates with full details in writing in a timely manner
12. To Profit Share according to prior agreement and/or written agency contracts/agreements with another member
13. To honour and reimburse any funds/disbursements paid out on my instructions by a fellow partner
14. To acknowledge its is my responsibility to inform the GFP Board of any delinquencies and report any dispute, financial or otherwise, involving another GFP Partner and thereafter to seek help from the GFP Board for dispute resolution
15. To acknowledge it is my responsibility to keep the GFP Partners informed promptly of any changes to my company's name, staff, contact details, countries regulations etc
16. To endeavour to attend the annual conference (AGM) of the Global Forwarding Partners at the venue voted for by the members. I agree that non attendance will result in a penalty up to USD 1000 which I will pay
17. Shipments consigned to the Bank requires Bank Endorsement prior to release of shipment, we acknowledge our responsibility for additional charges if this action is not carried out by our company
18. We understand that information regarding our companies payments, organisation & disputes could be disclosed to organisations outside of the GFP network
19. To pay Membership, AGM, Bank charges or associated fees by immediate payment
20. We understand that the Chairman and Board have a responsibility to expand the network by appointing new members which we fully support.
21. We acknowledge the Payment Netting System and will enter into this system when called upon by the GFP or its Secretary
22. Should our company fail to attend an AGM, we show our commitment by paying in advance the AGM Fee & Membership Fee for the following year

I understand that I may leave the GFP Network at any time. No fees will be refunded, in whole or in part. I have read and understood the above terms and conditions and agree to abide by them.
